Team Captain Instructions

THANKS to all of our Team Captains who have stepped up to make this campaign a huge success. Here's what you need to know to get started:

1. BUILD YOUR TEAM

Recruit 4 or 5 friends to participate with you. Tell them about all of the fun and excitement of the bowling day (2 hours of bowling, free Pizza Delight pizza, prizes, a fun Superhero theme, and a great feeling from doing something positive to help kids right here in Greater Halifax!)

*Stress the importance of meeting the **minimum pledge requirement of \$100 per participant.***

Your team kit should have all of the materials you need to help you get started. We have included a poster you can put up in your staff / lunch room to let everyone know you are taking part in our campaign.

2. REGISTER YOUR TEAM

Please register as soon as possible to ensure your place in the event. Lanes are assigned on a first come, first served basis. You can **FAX** the registration form included in the team package to 465-4281, or give us a **CALL** at 466-KIDS (5437), or **ONLINE** at www.bowlforkids.ca

3. HAVE FUN!

On your bowling day, please bring your online pledge report and/or pledge sheet (with all of your contact information filled in) to registration. ***(It is important to keep your online pledges separate from the pledges on your paper pledge form for accounting purposes)***. Arriving 15 minutes before your scheduled time will enable you to check in, get your bowling shoes and check out the prize area before you hit the lanes for some fun! There will be opportunities to purchase raffle tickets and 50/50 tickets during the event, so if you want to participate, it's a good idea to have some change in your pocket.

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Ways to Collect Pledges

ONLINE

Our on-line pledging service can be accessed by visiting our website: www.bowforkids.ca

Using this innovative service, you can create a **personalized message/web-page** to e-mail to your friends, family and co-workers requesting their support with a few clicks of the mouse. You can also enter offline pledges you might receive as cash or cheques, instead of using a pledge sheet. This page will offer your supporters the opportunity to respond immediately and use their credit card or request an invoice by printing off a donation form. Plus, online donors receive their official tax receipt immediately by email. This is quick, easy and cost-effective!

DIRECT DONOR BILLING

With direct donor billing, Big Brothers Big Sisters will collect your pledges of **\$20 or more**. Just fill in the donor's complete contact information on the pledge sheet and put a check mark in the "Bill" column...we'll take care of the rest!

PLEDGE SHEET

You can also use the paper pledge sheet for pledge collection. Bring your pledge sheet and collected donations to the bowling centre during your scheduled bowling time and pass them in at the registration desk. Be sure to fill in all of your contact information on the top of the sheet so all of the pledges get credited to your team.

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Fund Raising Tips & Ideas

Here's a little help to get you thinking about ways to raise money for your **Bowl for Kids Sake** team:

1. Hold a raffle or auction. Ask people or businesses you know to donate items and sell tickets.
2. Designate your office Casual Day fund.
3. Have a lunch-time bake sale.
4. Provide a candy-gram service for Valentine's Day.
5. Hold a weekly 50/50 draw.
6. Ask your employer to match your team's contribution (we'll provide a tax receipt!). Many companies have a Matching Gift policy.
7. Put a coin box at your reception area.
8. Hold a flea market.
9. Go door-to-door and ask your neighbours for a pledge.
10. Have a dinner party. Ask your guests to make a pledge to Bowl for Kids Sake instead of bringing a hostess gift.
11. Get the cafeteria in your office building to designate an item on the menu for which they will give a donation for every one sold.
12. Hold a recycling day. Put up notices, then go door-to-door collecting returnable bottles etc.
13. Have a coin drive. Get a large container and place it in your staff room. Ask people to empty their pockets of change.
14. "Buy a Bowl for Bowl". Have a potluck lunch day. Ask each team member to make a dish, then sell lunch to your colleagues.
15. Ask everyone with whom you do business (clients, realtor, dentist, stylist, plumber, mechanic etc.) to support your efforts with a donation.

NOTE: *For group fund-raising initiatives, you can divide the funds among each team member's pledge sheet so everyone can be eligible for a prize, or you can put all of the funds on one team sheet and collect one prize for the team to share. Please be sure to organize these monies before checking in at the bowling centre to facilitate your registration process.*

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
